



*1 Timothy 2:5, “For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;”*

## I. THE REVELATION OF OUR MEDIATOR

### A. CHRIST IS A RESURRECTED MEDIATOR (HEB 1:13, 4:14, 10:10-12)

*“Babaji (one of their illumined ones) is in constant communion with Christ; together they send out vibrations of redemption, and have planned the spiritual technique of salvation for this age. The work of these two fully-illumined masters—one with the body, and one without it—is to inspire the nations to forsake suicidal wars, race hatreds, religious sectarianism, and the boomerang-evils of materialism.” - Paramahansa Yogananda*

The new aged religions take our God and place Him on the same level as Babaji, their illumined one.

### B. CHRIST IS A RESTORING MEDIATOR (HEBREWS 4:15)

1. God restores through salvation.

*1 Timothy 2:3-4, “<sup>3</sup> For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; <sup>4</sup> Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.”*

2. God restores through advocacy.

*1 John 2:1, “My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:”*

*Acts 4:12, “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”*

## II. THE RELATIONSHIP WITH OUR MEDIATOR (HEBREWS 4:15)

### A. CHRIST EMPATHIZES WITH OUR INFIRMITIES (HEBREWS 4:15)

The phrase “touched with the feeling” comes from the word *sumpatheo* which is where we get our word *sympathy*. Christ sympathizes with us. He feels with us.

### B. CHRIST ENTERED INTO OUR INFIRMITIES (HEBREWS 4:15)

In every way that man could be tempted, Christ was tempted. When you come to God for victory over temptation, you are coming to one who has felt what we feel and who has been tempted like we are.

## III. THE RESPONSE TO OUR MEDIATOR (HEBREWS 4:16)

### A. WE NEED TO ADHERE TO OUR PROFESSION (HEB 4:14, 10:19-25)

As the day of the Lord’s return approaches, we’re not supposed to embrace the philosophies of this world, but are supposed to hold fast to that which God has given to us and be thankful for our salvation.

### B. WE NEED TO ACKNOWLEDGE HIS INVITATION (HEBREWS 4:16)

*1 John 1:9, “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”*

*Romans 3:23, “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;”*

### C. WE NEED TO ACCEPT HIS GRACE (HEBREWS 4:16)

*Romans 8:15-16, “<sup>15</sup> For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. <sup>16</sup> The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:”*

*Ephesians 2:8-9, “<sup>8</sup> For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: <sup>9</sup> Not of works, lest any man should boast.”*
